



Micro Baby Blanket Pattern

In loving memory of Evan James Chrysler



Ch = chain

Sc = single crochet

Dc = double crochet

Sl = slip stitch

Hook size = 3.5 E or 4.0 F

Directions

- Make slip knot
- Ch 22
- Row 1 – dc in 2nd ch from the hook. Dc in each chain all the way down (20 dc)
- Ch 2 and turn project
- Rows 2-10 – dc in each stitch. ch 2 at the end and turn project
- Border – sc all the way around your project.
- Sl together
- Ch 1
- Sc in 1st stitch
- Skip a stitch
- 5 dc in the next stitch
- Skip a stitch
- Sc in the next stitch
- Repeat this pattern all the way around your project
- Tie off and weave in ends

To make this blanket bigger or smaller, add or subtract however many ch in the beginning. You might have more or fewer than 10 rows depending on the size you choose. Once you have a decent square, add a border. The number of rows does not matter.
