

## Micro Baby Hat Pattern

In loving memory of Evan James Chrysler

Ch = chain

Sc = single crochet

Dc = double crochet

Dcinc = double crochet increase

St = slip stitch

Hook size = 3.5 E or 4.0 F



### Directions

**\*Ch 2 At beginning of each round does NOT count as a stitch.\*** (By slip stitching to the top of the first stitch from each row, we avoid having a hole or a visible seam. If you need help with how to do an invisible join, [here](#) is a link to a helpful video.)

- Make magic circle, Ch2
- Row1: 10dc in the magic circle (10) Pull magic circle yarn tail tight. Sl St to the top of the first dc to join.
- Row2: (1 dc, dcinc) Repeat all the way around. Sl St to join. (15)

End of row 3, plus chain 2 to start row 4:

First dc of next round will go here




- Row3: Ch 2. dc 15. Sl St to top of first dc to join. (15)
- Row4: repeat row 3
- Row5: Ch1, sc 15. Sl St to join & fasten off, or invisible join.

## Finished beanie



To make this hat bigger or smaller just add or subtract however many dc in the magic circle as you would like. You may also need to add a few more rows of dc to make it symmetrical depending on how big you make the hat.
